**A.** Comprehensive Project As per the CBSE guidelines every student of class 12<sup>th</sup> have to prepare a Comprehensive accountancy project. In the project student are required to make a sole proprietorship and make it accounts for a year ending. Some points that you should keep in mind while preparing project file:

- **STORY:** There should be nicely written story in the project. The story should include all the major decisions of the firm. It should give an overview of the business. Students are advised not to add all the entries to the story. There should be 7 adjustment entries in project which should be shown in story.
- **CAPITAL:** Since students are required to prepare accounts of sole proprietorship, capital of the firm should not exceed 50 lakhs.
- **JOURNAL:** There should be around 35-45 journal entries. There should be some entries related to Pre-Operative Expenses.
- **LEDGER:** There should be around 25-30 ledger accounts. Ledger Accounts should be closed with Trading A/c and Profit and Loss A/c.

- **Balance Sheet**
