Activity 1

Read books to discover lots of new things!! From the story books you read make a word tree using the words (new and difficult words) which you have learned from the story.

- Panchatantra Stories (Level2, Age: 6 to 8 years)
- Little Red Riding Hood (Level2, Age: 6 to 8 years)
- The Shoemaker And The Elves (Level2, Age: 6 to 8 years)



To make a word tree:

- Draw a tree on A4 coloured sheet.
- Cut leaves out of different coloured sheets (2 inches).
- Write one word that you have learnt on each leaf. Stick these leaves on the branches of the word tree. Write the meanings of the new and difficult words on A4 coloured sheet.
- Attach atleast three leaves every week in your summer Holidays.

Activity 2

Care For The Environment

- Learn to take care of plants and animals around you.
- Water the plants at your home and garden every day.
- Nature will love you if you love it. So, visit a nearby park and feed birds with bajara and water.
- Keep a bowl of water outside in a balcony/ terrace for the birds to drink.
- Try the following activities.

Recycled Plant Pots



- Do not throw away big used containers.
- Make beautiful plant pots for the kitchen windows.
- Paint them with bright colours on the outside.
- Now make a hole at the base of the pot.
- Fill the pot with soil and your beautiful plant pot is ready. Plant a sapling in the pot.
- Bring it to school.
- Students have to bring decorative materials and decorate the pot in the school after the vacation.

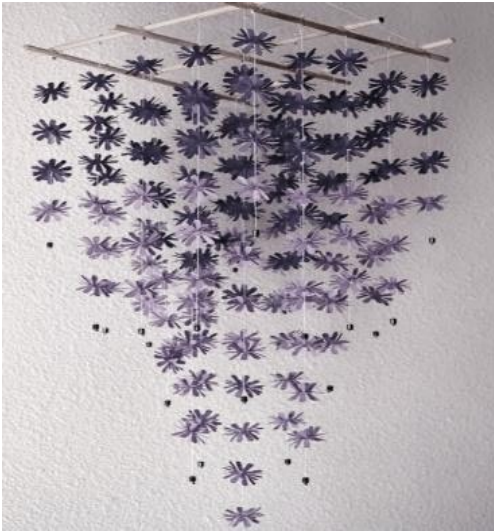
Make A Pencil Holder

- Take any used container.
- Cover it with coloured paper and keep your pencils, colours etc in it.

Activity 3

Make a chandelier

Snowflake scramble



- Write the word **SNOWFLAKE** on a piece of chart paper and paste it on a cardboard (5" X 10").
- Make as many words as you can, by using letters from the word SNOWFLAKE.
- Write the words on colourful cut outs of flowers, stars or any other shape.
- Paste the cutouts on a thick thread and prepare such eight strings.
- Paste or attach the strings with the cardboard and your beautiful chandelier is ready now.

Activity 4

Dice Addition and Subtraction Fun

To make a dice

- Take a cardboard and make two cubes of same size (8"X8").
- Cover them with fluorescent yellow and blue sheets.
- Make dots on its each side with black colour.
- Your dice are ready.
- Bring the dice in the school.



Play time

- Write a target number on a slate (small board) for all to see for example 100.
- Each player will roll both the dice together.
- Write the numbers on A4 coloured sheet and add them.
- Again roll the dice and add the numbers with the previous sum (total).
- Repeat it until one of the players crosses the target number 100.

Activity 5

Blow Painting

There are a lot of fun activities that can be done using water. Let's try one out.

Materials Required

- Newspaper
- A drawing sheet
- Four small sized bowls
- Some straws
- Water colours
- A small brush

Steps to follow:

- Spread a newspaper on the table. Keep a drawing sheet on it.
- Take different water colours in four bowls and mix water in them.
- Take a brush and drop some colour over the sheet.
- Using a straw, blow each blob of colour in different directions to mix the colours.
- Repeat these steps with all the colours. Let the painting dry.
- Your beautiful blow painting is ready. Frame it and bring to school.
