ACTIVITY - DIALOGUE COMPLETION

Dialogue writing is an art of talking which occurs when two persons converse with each other. By dialogue writing we can increase our conversational skills and imagination. While writing a dialogue, we should keep in mind certain points and guidelines which are given below.

GUIDELINES :

- 1. Ask questions or write an answer to the questions in the dialogue.**
- 2. Special attention should be paid to the opening sentence and conclusion.**
- 3. Write the dialogue in as natural, interesting and realistic manner as possible. Views of the two persons should be simple and easily understood.**
- 4. The whole conversation should be brief and the questions and replies as concise as possible.**

Key points of Dialogue Writing

- **The entire dialogue should be read once, to get an understanding of the type of conversation, so that we can fill the gaps accordingly.**
- **Care should be taken that the meaning of the conversation does not change.**
- **The type of language (formal or informal) used should be grammatically correct.**
- **Sentences used in a dialogue should be clearly understood, i.e. whether a question is being asked or a request is being made.**
- **IMPORTANT: DO NOT GIVE ONE WORD ANSWERS!**
