Activities have been designed to keep children involved, enhance their knowledge and develop their skills.

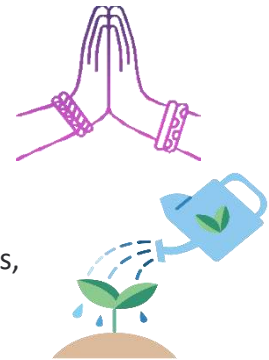
These activities are to be done under the guidance and supervision of parents. Let's make this a joint effort- by you as a parent and we as a school to achieve the targets.
